Being Me In My World - Who am I and how do I fit in?

Children will build positive relationships to create a classroom community for everyone to feel welcome. This will help us to work together and make our classroom a better place. We will learn how to care for each other and begin to work collaboratively as a class. We will begin to learn behaviour expectations and the importance of following the classroom charter.



Festivals and Celebrations

Halloween, Harvest and Hull Fair

Children will explore the Halloween and Harvest theme and explain why and how these festivals are celebrated.

Children will be aware of the arrival of Hull Fair and look into its history. They will make and taste a variety of food associated with the fair.



Where shall we go and how do we get there?

Where do I live? My house and my street.

Children will look at simple pictures and maps of where they live and where our school is in relation to their street.

Children will draw simple maps of the local area, identify key places such as East Park, local shops etc. and talk about the different types of homes people live in.



World of Work

Jobs of me and my family

Children will be aware of their own immediate family and share knowledge about them.

Children will learn about how they can help at home and school and what role they play.

Jobs and occupations will be explored and links will be made with family and school.



Growing and Changes

Animals, Vegetables and Pumpkins



Children will explore the seasonal change of Autumn and explain what happens when Autumn arrives. We will also learn about the Artist Yayoi Kusama and look at her work in more detail. We will take inspiration to create our own. We will also look at nocturnal and diurnal animals and what hibernation means.



Fabulous Food

Tasting and Making Hull Fair Food

Hull Fair food is a tradition of the city and children will get to make and taste a wide variety of food that the fair has to offer. Children will use their senses to further develop their understanding of likes and dislikes and they will be able to communicate this with others. Children will also take part in voting.



My Life

Who am I within my family?

Children will learn about themselves and investigate parts of their body. They will use a mirror to identify facial features to produce a self portrait using paint and the correct colours as well as colour mixing.

Children will then expand on this and explore their own family tree.

Children will explore which animals make good pets and how we look after them through role play and investigation. Children will carry out their own research using non-fiction.

Children will share if they have any pets and pictures will be sent via Tapestry from home to help them share information with others.
