As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will:

be focusing on our consolidating our Arithmetic skills.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Writing a suspense story using powerful description to create a sense of mystery, whilst using a range of vocabulary and punctuation to engage the reader.

Writing a balanced argument giving reasons **FOR** and **AGAINST**, using formal vocabulary and a range of causal conjunctions.

As **READERS** we will be:

Reading *Goodnight Mr Tom* by Michelle Magorian.

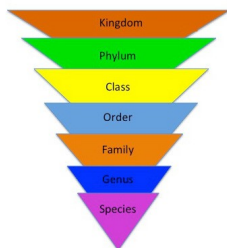
We will clarify words to increase our vocabulary, make inferences from the text, predict what we think might happen and summarise paragraphs and chapters.

In **Geography** we will be:

Learning about capital continents, countries and cities of North and south America and comparing the different continents and climates, identifying physical and human features, of the Ukkand America.

In **Science** we will be:

Comparing and classifying humans and animals according to their different characteristics, classifying using the Linnaean system, and describing helpful and harmful organisms.



In **R.W** we will be:

Exploring issues of justice and freedom, exploring religious teachings of reconciliation and forgiveness and identifying ways communities can live together for the well being of all.

(RW, Religion and World Views, is the subject previously known as RE)

In **Art** we will be:

Researching the work of Peter Voulkos, sculptor, and how his work influenced the art world and society today, looking at shapes, colours, design, patterns within his work, collecting visual and other information to help us develop ideas using images from The Exhibition at The Tower of London then making a clay poppy.
