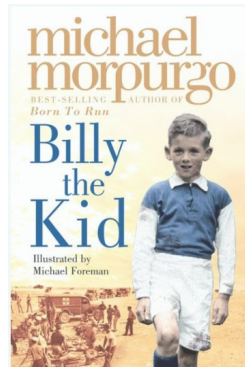

How did the Romans Change Britain?

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Using our Driver text "Billy the Kid" to inspire our historical story writing using figurative language.

We will also be learning to write to persuade people. In poetry we will be performing poems.

We will continue to learn how to edit and improve our work to ensure it is the best it can be.

As **READERS** we will be:

Developing our phonics through RWI.

Reading Billy the Kid by Michael Morpurgo

Reading a range of other quality texts.

We will make inferences from the text and predict what we think might happen next.

In **Science** we will be:

Learning about light. In particular:

- How we need light to see
- Natural and artificial light sources
- How shadows are formed

We will make observations of shadow changes throughout the day.

In **R.W.** we will be:

Learning about Encounters. We will be thinking about different acts of worship, where they happen and what objects are used as part of worship.

(RW, Religion and World Views, is the subject previously known as RE)

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will be:

Learning how to carry out column addition and subtraction (regrouping ones and tens) accurately and efficiently.

Securing the x2, x4 and x8 multiplication tables, recognising the relationships between them, and using this knowledge to solve problems.

Scale known multiplication facts by 10.

In **History** we will be:

Learning about the Roman invasion.

Discovering how and why the Romans changed Britain.

Considering what is meant by "The Roman Empire" and look at aspects of daily life such as homes, food and jobs.

In **Art** we will be:

Looking at examples of Roman vases and then designing, sculpting, decorating and evaluating our own.
