As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will:

Learning about right angles and identifying them in shapes.

We will also be manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculation.

As **WRITERS** we will be:

Learning about similes and metaphors and then writing a simile poem.

We will be writing our own story based on the book Flat Stanley.

We will also be writing a recount/diary entry of the day in which he got flattened.

As **READERS** we will be:

Developing our phonics through RWI.

In **History** we will be:
