- Changes of state

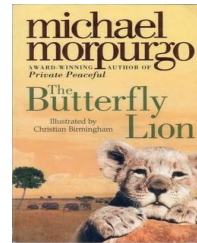
Think of an idea about one of these areas and create an experiment to test your idea.
