writing our own Free Verse Poem which will include alliteration, similes and expanded noun phrases.

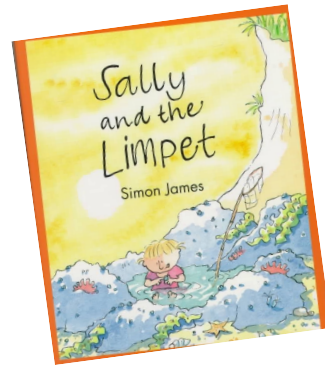
In our fiction writing we will be using our driver text to help with writing our own story about overcoming a challenge.

We will investigate how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to be able to grow healthily. We will find out about plants which grow in our local environment and finally, we will learn how plants reproduce.

As **READERS** we will be:

reading *Sally and the Limpet* by Simon Jones as our Driver text in English and using it as the inspiration for our own writing.

We will also continue to read during our Read, Write Inc. Phonics sessions or in our Guided Reading group.

In **R.W.** we will be:

Thinking about some big questions in religion, who is God? Where is God? Why do bad things happen?

We will also be learning about creation stories.

Finally, we will discuss some Christian, Jewish and Humanist responses to some big questions.

As **MATHEMATICIANS** we will:

learning about money, knowing that different combinations of coins can have the same value and solving problems with money.

Learn that a fraction is an equal part of a whole and identify and find  $1/2$ ,  $1/4$  and  $1/3$ s.

Compare and sequence intervals of time and tell and write the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

In **Geography** we will:

compare Hull with our Twinned City, Freetown, in Sierra Leone. We will be able to locate them on a world map, we will look at the human and physical features of the cities and find similarities and differences between them. Finally we will compare our lives in Hull with the lives of children in Freetown.

In **ART** we will be:

inspired by *On the Beach* by Picasso. We will learn a range of sketching techniques and how to mix our own paint colours, shades and tints. Then, we will use these skills to create our own beach painting.
